EA/LPU

Early Arrival (EA)

EA is available starting at 7:30am. This relaxed, indoor care program takes place in the Dayhouse environment for children enrolled in Children's House, Elementary, and Middle School. EA takes place in the Toddler environment for Toddlers. Children are invited to bring and eat their breakfasts if they arrive before 8 am.

Late Pickup (LPU)

LPU 1 is available until 4:30 and LPU 2 is available until 5:30 pm. This is a care program where children can enjoy a variety of age-appropriate activities like puzzles, games, LEGOs, trains, art, reading, etc. Children will also enjoy time in the gym or outside daily. Snack is provided daily including milk. LPU takes place in the Toddler environment for Toddlers. Children's House LPU is held in the Dayhouse and Elementary/Middle School is in the LPU room and media center.

Drop-in EA & LPU

EA & LPU may be used on an as-needed basis provided there is space. These placements will only be assigned a maximum of 2 weeks in advance. This service is generally meant for a last-minute or emergency resource. There is an additional \$1 charge per time used.

Registration for EA & LPU

To register, please fill out a registration form available at the reception desk. EA & LPU are available on a contractual basis. Due to limited space in these programs, we accept registrations on a first-come, first-serve basis. You must reserve a consistent weekly schedule. Priority is given first to full time, followed by part-time schedules. All services will be invoiced on the 15th following the month of service and are withdrawn on the 20th of the month via auto withdraw. Please note: you will be billed for this whenever School is scheduled to be in session based on the RMS calendar, whether you use it or not. We require a 2 week notice to accommodate changes in your schedule. Late fees will be assessed for children being picked up late of \$1.00 per minute after the first 5 minutes.
